Use this form if submitting a paper check or money order to pay a tax balance due on a 2013 Form 60 that was filed without payment. Do not use this form if paying electronically - see "How to make payment" for payment options.

Do not use Form 60-PV to make an extension payment. Extension payments should be made using the extension payment voucher, Form 60-EXT.

When is the payment due?

The payment must be made on or before the 15th day of the 4th month following the end of the tax year to avoid any late payment penalty or interest.

How to make payment

Electronic payment option. Instead of submitting a paper check or money order with this payment voucher, the balance due may be paid electronically through an Automated Clearing House (ACH) credit transaction or online through Link2Gov Corporation, a national electronic payment service. *If paying electronically, do not use this paper voucher.*

To pay by means of an ACH transaction, go to **www.nd.gov/tax** and click on "S Corp and Partnership" on the left-hand side of the page. Then click on "Electronic Payment."

To pay online through Link2Gov Corporation, go to **www.ndtaxpayment.com**. Link2Gov charges a fee for its service, none of which goes to the State of North Dakota. The amount of the fee will be provided during the transaction with an option to continue or cancel the transaction.
