Use **Form CT-1120FP** to claim the business tax credit available under Conn. Gen. Stat. §12-127jj for qualified film production. Attach it to **Form CT-1120K**, *Business Tax Credit Summary* and/or **Form CT-207K**, *Insurance/Health Care Tax Credit Schedule*.

The Film Production tax credit is administered by the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) and may not be claimed until DECD issues a tax credit voucher which lists the amount of the available tax credit.

The Film Production tax credit may be applied against the taxes imposed under Chapter 207 and Chapter 208 of the Connecticut General Statutes. This tax credit may be assigned in whole or in part no more than three times.

Claim Period

All or any part of the tax credit may be claimed in the year the production expenses or costs were incurred or in any of the three succeeding years after the year the production expenses or costs were incurred.

Credit Percentage

This credit is calculated based on a percentage of qualified production expenses or costs. The percentage depends on the amount of production expenses or costs, as follows:

At least \$100,000 but not more than \$500,000	10% of production expenses or costs
More than \$500,000 but not more than \$1 million	15% of production expenses or costs
More than \$1 million	30% of production expenses or costs
