



2016 Estate/Trust Estimated Tax Payment Form

Instructions

Estimated tax is not required for estates or trusts. However, these forms are provided for those who prefer filing estimated tax. These forms should **not** be used to remit payment on behalf of individual beneficiaries of the estate or trust.

Calculating the Payment

Estimated tax payments can be made on a quarterly basis. When making payments, be sure to use the same account numbers that are used when filing the annual 105 return.

It is strongly recommended that these payments be submitted electronically to avoid problems and delays. The single form can be copied and used for each of the four quarterly payments if an electronic payment cannot be made for any reason.

Penalties

There is no penalty for failure to file estimated tax for estates or trusts.

Go Green with Revenue Online

www.Colorado.gov/RevenueOnline allows taxpayers to file taxes, make payments and monitor their accounts. Form 105EP is not required if an electronic payment is paid through this site. Please be advised that a nominal processing fee may apply to online payments.

Pay by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)

EFT payments can be made safely and for free, and can be scheduled up to 12 months ahead of time to avoid forgetting to make a payment. This requires pre-registration before payments can be made. Visit www.Colorado.gov/revenue/eft for registration information.

File only if you are making a payment of estimated tax.
