


What Is Form RI-1040C-V and Do You Need To Use It?

It is a statement you send with your payment of any balance due on line 21 of your Form RI-1040C. Using Form RI-1040C-V allows us to process your payment more accurately and efficiently. We strongly encourage you to use Form RI-1040C-V, but there is no penalty if you do not do so.

How To Fill In Form RI-1040C-V



- Box 1. Enter the name and address as shown on your return. If the return is for a fiscal year, enter the fiscal years date in the space provided.
- Box 2. Enter the Federal employer identification number in the box provided.
- Box 3. Enter the amount of the payment you are making. Also, enter the payment information below for your records.

How To Prepare Your Payment

Make your check or money order payable to the "R.I. Division of Taxation." Do not send cash. Make sure the name and address appears on the check or money order. Write "Form RI-1040C-V," your daytime phone number and the federal employer identification number on your check or money order.

How To Send In Your Return, Payment, and RI-1040C-V

Retain the top portion of this form for your records. Detach and return the lower portion with your payment. DO NOT staple or otherwise attach your payment of Form RI-1040C-V to your return or to each other. Instead, just put them loose in an envelope. Mail your tax return, payment and Form RI-1040C-V to the Rhode Island Division of Taxation, One Capitol Hill, Providence, RI 02908-5807.

DO NOT USE THIS VOUCHER TO MAKE A PAYMENT ON YOUR PERSONAL INCOME TAX RETURN. THIS VOUCHER IS TO BE USED BY AN ENTITY FILING A COMPOSITE TAX RETURN.
