

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



School District Year 2016 Estimated Income Tax Payments Worksheet #1: <u>Traditional</u> Tax Base

Use this worksheet to determine your liability for school district income tax due to a <u>traditional</u> tax base school district.

If you filed a school district income tax return for year 2015 and if you will be making estimates based on the "last year's tax" method, skip lines 1 through 8 and enter on line 9 below 100% of the tax shown on line 4 of the 2015 SD 100.

Note 1: If you move during the year and will be residing in more than one district that imposes the school district income tax, you will need to complete a separate worksheet for each school district.

Note 2: You can avoid paying school district estimated income tax if the sum of (i) your 2016 Ohio income tax withholding and (ii) your 2016 school district income tax withholding and (iii) \$500 is equal to or greater than the sum of your 2016 Ohio income tax and your 2016 school district income tax.

What Are My Payment Options?

There are three payment options available to you:

- Electronic Check Save time and postage by electronically filing and paying your 2016 quarterly estimates. Simply go to our Web site at tax.ohio.gov for this electronic payment option. Using this method of payment eliminates the need for you to file a paper copy of SD 100ES.
- Credit Card You may use your Discover, VISA, MasterCard or American Express card to pay your estimated school district income taxes. You may make your credit card payments by either visiting tax.ohio.gov or by calling 1-800-2PAY-TAX (1-800-272-9829). The Ohio jurisdiction code is 6446. Official Payments

charges a convenience fee equal to 2.5% (or \$1, whichever is greater). This fee is paid directly to Official Payments Corporation and is based on the amount of your tax payment. Do not file voucher SD 100ES if you use the credit card method of payment.

 Check or Money Order – You may send in a personal check or money order made payable to the School District Income Tax with your quarterly estimated SD 100ES. Mail to the address printed on the voucher. Do not send cash.

Note 3: HB 483 implemented a change to the exemption amount claimed beginning with the 2014 tax return. The personal and dependent exemption is now a graduated amount based on your Ohio adjusted gross income. See chart below:

Ohio Adjusted Gross Income	Personal/ Dependent Exemption
\$40,000 or less	\$2,200
More than \$40,000, but not more than \$80,000	\$1,950
More than \$80,0000	\$1,700
