

CONTRIBUTION ADJUSTMENT WORKSHEET

Use this worksheet to calculate the adjustment amount to enter on Form ND-1, line 4, if you itemized your deductions for federal income tax purposes on Schedule A (Form 1040)\* and either of the following apply:

- You are claiming a credit on both Schedule ND-1PG, line 7, and Schedule ND-1QEC, line 5.
- You are claiming an endowment fund credit from an estate, trust, partnership, or S corporation (North Dakota Schedule K-1).

**Exceptions to use of worksheet.** Do not complete this worksheet and do not enter any amount on Form ND-1, line 4, if you claimed the standard deduction on your 2021 Form 1040, line 12a, and you are not claiming a credit on Schedule ND-1QEC, line 5, that is based on a contribution made from an individual retirement account (IRA) under I.R.C. § 408(d).
