Instructions for Form IT-205-V **Payment Voucher for Fiduciary Income Tax Returns**

When to use this form

If you are paying New York State tax for a fiduciary income tax return (Form IT-205) by check or money order, you must include Form IT-205-V with your payment.

How to fill out your check or money order

- 1. Make your check or money order payable in U.S. funds to New York State Income Tax.
- 2. Write the estate or trust's employer identification number (EIN), the tax year, and *Income Tax* on it.

Completing the voucher

You must complete all information on the voucher to be sure your payment is credited to your account.

- 1. Enter the tax year from the fiduciary income tax return you are filing.
- 2. Enter the estate's or trust's:
 - a. name (exactly as shown on federal Form SS-4),
 - b. entire EIN,
 - c. fiscal year begin date and end date if applicable,
 - d. name and title of fiduciary, and
 - e. address.
- 3. If you are entering a foreign address:
 - a. Enter the city, province, or state all in the City, village, or post office box.

- b. Enter the **full** country name in the *Country* box. Do **not** abbreviate.
- c. Enter the postal code, if any, in the ZIP code box.
- 4. Do not staple or clip your payment to Form IT-205-V. Place it loose in the envelope.

Mailing address

E-filed and previously filed returns

If you e-filed your fiduciary income tax return (Form IT-205), or if you are making a payment for a previously filed return, mail the voucher and payment to:

Paper returns

If you are filing a paper fiduciary income tax return (including amended returns), include the voucher and payment with your return and mail to this address:

If you are not using U.S. Mail, see Publication 55, Designated Private Delivery Services.

Fee for payments returned by banks – The law allows the Tax Department to charge a \$50 fee when a check, money order, or electronic payment is returned by a bank for nonpayment. However, if an electronic payment is returned as a result of an error by the bank or the department, the department won't charge the fee. If your payment is returned, we will send a separate bill for \$50 for each return or other tax document associated with the returned payment.
