

APPLY FOR A PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE ONLINE WITH myPATH

myPATH | PENNSYLVANIA TAX HUB

 Pennsylvanians can visit mypath.pa.gov to file Property Tax/Rent Rebate applications. Applicants will be asked to provide specific information on income received and property taxes or rent paid.

Benefits of filing electronically using myPATH include:

- » Fast processing and direct deposit
- » Error-reducing automatic calculators
- » Security features to safeguard sensitive information
- » User-friendly features not available when filing by paper
- » The “Where’s My Rebate?” system to track the status of a claim online



It’s free to apply for a rebate and assistance is available at hundreds of locations across the state, including **Department of Revenue district offices**, **local Area Agencies on Aging**, senior centers, and state legislators’ offices. Applicants are encouraged to call ahead to confirm whether an appointment is required.



Applicants who wish to file by paper may obtain **Property Tax/Rent Rebate claim forms (PA-1000)** and related information at revenue.pa.gov/ptrr or by calling 1-800-362-2050.

Applicants must apply every year because rebates are based on annual income and property taxes or rent paid during the prior year. Applicants need to include all of the required documentation for the claim year when filing. This information is needed whether filing online or by paper.
