1	Number of qualifying children under age 4	1	
2	Multiply line 1 by 1,000	2	.00
3	Number of qualifying children at least 4 years old but under age 17	3	
4	Multiply line 3 by 330	4	.00
5	Add lines 2 and 4	5	.00
6	Enter your federal adjusted gross income rounded down to the nearest \$1,000 (see instructions)	6	.00
7	Is the amount on line 6 less than the amount for your filing status?: Married filing a joint return - \$110,000 Single, head of household or qualifying surviving spouse - \$75,000 Married filing a separate return - \$55,000 If yes , enter 0 If no , subtract the amount for your filing status from line 6 and enter the result		
8	Multiply line 7 by 1.65% (.0165)	8	.00
9	Subtract line 8 from line 5. This is your Empire State child credit (see instructions)	9	.00
